

Francesca Palandri currently works at the Institute of Haematology/Oncology, IRCSS St Orsola-Malpighi University Hospital (Bologna). In 2009, she obtained her PhD, with a research focus on the biology and treatment of myeloproliferative neoplasia. She is now Head of the Inpatient Unit for the treatment of Philadelphia-negative myeloproliferative neoplasms (MPNs) at the Institute of Haematology "L and A Seràgnoli". Prof. Palandri's key interest areas include optimising treatment and the importance of mutation burden in MPNs. She has authored >200 peer-reviewed papers, and over 300 abstracts presented at international meetings. She has presented her work at international congresses and served as Chair for meetings focussed on treatment strategies for MPNs.
